Deuteronomy 18:17	And the LORD said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken.
Deuteronomy 18:18	I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him. (Jesus Christ will raise up a prophet, He will put His word in his mouth to guide us.)
Deuteronomy 18:19	And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him. (If we fail to hearken unto the Lord through His prophets, it is a sin unto us.)
Deuteronomy 18:20	But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die. (The Lord will remove that prophet.)
Deuteronomy 18:21	And <u>if thou say in thine heart, How shall we know the word which the LORD hath not spoken?</u>
Deuteronomy 18:22	When a prophet speaketh in the name of the LORD, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him.
Deuteronomy 34:9	And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.
Deuteronomy 34:10	And there arose not a prophet since in Israel like unto Moses, whom <b>the LORD knew face to face</b> ,
Judges 6:8	That the LORD sent a prophet unto the children of Israel, which said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I brought you up from Egypt, and

brought you forth out of the house of bondage;



1 Samuel 3:20	And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel <u>was established to</u> <u>be a prophet of the LORD</u> .
1 Samuel 9:9	(Beforetime in Israel, when a man went to enquire of God, thus he spake, <u>Come</u> , <u>and let us go to the seer: for he that is now called a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer</u> .) (A prophet is a Seer also.)
2 Samuel 12:25	And he sent by the hand of <u>Nathan the prophet</u> ; and he called his name Jedidiah, because of the LORD.
2 Samuel 24:11	For when David was up in the morning, the word of the LORD came unto the prophet Gad, David's seer, saying,
1 Kings 1:45	And Zadok the priest and Nathan <b>the prophet have anointed</b> him king in Gihon: and they are come up from thence rejoicing, so that the city rang again. This is the noise that ye have heard.

### Early Day Saints and today Latter Day Saints:

All through the Scriptures of the Bible, King James Version, God our Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ called all His people of His Church, "SAINTS".

We are not perfect, but trying and repenting and forsaking and cleaning the inner vessel.

(Saints called out in the Old Testament = 34 times and New Testament = 61 times)

#### Old Testament Saints (34):

Deuteronomy 33:2	And he said, The LORD came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir unto them; he shined forth from mount Paran, and he came with ten thousands of <u>saints</u> : from his right hand went a fiery law for them.
Deuteronomy 33:3	Yea, he loved the people; all his <u>saints</u> are in thy hand: and they sat down at thy feet; every one shall receive of thy words.
1 Samuel 2:9	He will keep the feet of his <u>saints</u> , and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail.



2 Chronicles 6:41	Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness.
Job 5:1	Call now, if there be any that will answer thee; and to which of the <u>saints</u> wilt thou turn?
Job 15:15	Behold, he putteth no trust in his saints; yea, the heavens are not clean in his sight.
Psalm 16:3	But to the <u>saints</u> that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight.
Psalm 30:4	Sing unto the LORD, O ye <u>saints</u> of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.
Psalm 31:23	O love the LORD, all ye his <u>saints</u> : for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.
Psalm 34:9	O fear the LORD, ye his <b>saints</b> : for there is no want to them that fear him.
Psalm 37:28	For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his <u>saints</u> ; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.
Psalm 50:5	Gather my <u>saints</u> together unto me; those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice.
Psalm 52:9	I will praise thee for ever, because thou hast done it: and I will wait on thy name; for it is good before thy <u>saints</u> .
Psalm 79:2	The dead bodies of thy servants have they given to be meat unto the fowls of the heaven, the flesh of thy <u>saints</u> unto the beasts of the earth.
Psalm 85:8	I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his <u>saints</u> : but let them not turn again to folly.
Psalm 89:5	And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD: thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the <u>saints</u> .
Psalm 89:7	God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the <u>saints</u> , and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him.
Psalm 97:10	Ye that love the LORD, hate evil: he preserveth the souls of his <b>saints</b> ; he delivereth them out of the hand of the wicked.



Psalm 116:15	Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his <u>saints</u> .
Psalm 132:9	Let thy priests be clothed with righteousness; and let thy <u>saints</u> shout for joy.
Psalm 132:16	I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her <u>saints</u> shall shout aloud for joy.
Psalm 145:10	All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee.
Psalm 148:14	He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his <u>saints</u> ; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD.
Psalm 149:1	Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of <u>saints</u> .
Psalm 149:5	Let the <u>saints</u> be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
Psalm 149:9	To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his <u>saints</u> . Praise ye the LORD.
Proverbs 2:8	He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his saints.
Daniel 7:18	But the <u>saints</u> of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever.
Daniel 7:21	I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;
Daniel 7:22	Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the <u>saints</u> of the most High; and the time came that the <u>saints</u> possessed the kingdom.
Daniel 7:25	And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the <u>saints</u> of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.
Daniel 7:27	And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the <u>saints</u> of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.
Hosea 11:12	Ephraim compasseth me about with lies, and the house of Israel with deceit: but Judah yet ruleth with God, and is faithful with the <u>saints</u> .
Zechariah 14:5	And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, and all the <u>saints</u> with thee.



#### **New Testament Saints (61):**

Ephesians 6:18	Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all <u>saints</u> ;
Philippians 1:1	Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the <u>saints</u> in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:
Philippians 4:22	All the <u>saints</u> salute you, chiefly they that are of Caesar's household.
Colossians 1:2	To the <u>saints</u> and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Colossians 1:4	Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the <u>saints</u> ,
Colossians 1:12	Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the <u>saints</u> in light:
Colossians 1:26	Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his <b>saints</b> :
1 Thessalonians 3:13	To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his <u>saints</u> .
2 Thessalonians 1:10	When he shall come to be glorified in his <b>saints</b> , and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.
1 Timothy 5:10	Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the <u>saints</u> ' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.
Philemon 1:5, 7	Hearing of thy love and faith, which thou hast toward the Lord Jesus, and toward all <u>saints</u> ;
Philemon 1:7	For we have great joy and consolation in thy love, because the bowels of the <u>saints</u> are refreshed by thee, brother.



Hebrews 6:10	For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the <u>saints</u> , and do minister.
Hebrews 13:24	Salute all them that have the rule over you, and all the <u>saints</u> . They of Italy salute you.
Jude 1:3	Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the <u>saints</u> .
Jude 1:14	And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,
Revelation 5:8	And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of <u>saints</u> .
Revelation 8:3	And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.
Revelation 8:4	And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the <u>saints</u> , ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.
Revelation 11:18	And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the <u>saints</u> , and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.
Revelation 13:7	And it was given unto him to make war with the <u>saints</u> , and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.
Revelation 13:10	He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the <u>saints</u> .
Revelation 14:12	Here is the patience of the <u>saints</u> : here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.
